ADVANCED METERING SYSTEM RIDER (AMS Rider)

APPLICABILITY

This Advanced Metering System Rider ("AMS") is applicable to all customers taking service under a retail rate listed below. The AMS Rider recovers the Company's costs incurred to deploy an Advanced Metering System. Retail electric service customers connected to the Company's system receiving metered service, except those taking service under transmission voltage rates, will be subject to Rate No. 46. The AMS Rider applicable to each rate class is provided in the Monthly Rate Rider section.

TERRITORY

Areas served by the EPE in Doña Ana, Sierra, Otero and Luna Counties.

TERM

The AMS Rider will be reflected in customer bills per month until modified by the New Mexico Public Regulation Commission.

MONTHLY RATE RIDER

The AMS Rider is charged per meter per month and is a component of the customer bill. The charge amount will appear as a separate line item on the customer monthly bill and shall be titled "Advanced Metering System Rider".


